From a visit to our expansive museum-quality Festival Store to learning something new in a hands-on workshop, from taking a gallery tour with one of our 200 artists to enjoying world class performances, from purchasing a new piece of art for your collection to dancing all night at the sexiest after-hours party in history, we are certain you will leave this Cabinet with your curiosity sated...at least until next year.


JURIED EXHIBITION

Each year we invite an entirely new jury to select the work for our expansive visual art exhibition.

This year, art critic Jen Graves (*The Stranger*), artist/curator Daniel Carrillo (Some Space Gallery), artist/writer Sharon Arnold (Dimensions Variable), and art consultant Dianne Elliott (D3 Consulting, Inc.) reviewed over 1,600 entries submitted by 400 artists from around the world.

The work the jury selected features a wide range of mediums, including watercolors, oil paintings, etchings; sculpture made from copper, fishing lures and porcelain; pencil drawings and digitally rendered illustration. Photography made up over 60% of the work submitted and virtually every subject matter and body part has been captured: the sweetest embrace, the tug of the rope; laughter and playing; a curvy hip, a succulent toe, a strong back, a sexy pair of hands; and, of course, those sometimes forbidden places that we finally get to reveal and celebrate throughout this exhibition.

ROGER BENINGTON

For 2010, Seattle Erotic Art Festival commissioned an original piece of performance art theater to complement the world-class visual art exhibition. Award-winning NYC-based director Roger Benington has written and directed this new work entitled, Cabaret de Curiosités.

Benington, born in Johannesburg, South Africa, was awarded the Andrew W. Mellon Foundation's Young Artist Fellowship to study directing at The Juilliard School. Past directing projects include Sedaris's The Santaland Diaries, God's Ear by Jenny Schwartz and Sarah Kane's Crave at Washington Ensemble Theatre, and *Project Fabulocity!*, an original play by and about queer youth in Salt Lake City. Various grants awarded Benington include the 2003-05 NEA/TCG Career Development Program Grant for Young Directors, a Jim Henson Foundation grant, and several grants from the Salt Lake City and Utah Arts Councils.
