#### JURIED EXHIBITION

The festival is known worldwide for its comprehensive collection of international fine art celebrating the diversity of human sexual expression. The incredible creativity with which artists approach the subject of erotica is captured in all manner of visual media: painting, photography, sculpture, assemblage, prints, and more.

This year, our jury reviewed 1,200 entries submitted by 294 artists from 34 states and 12 countries—which brings us a stunning diversity.

We are proud to present this world-class visual art exhibition, where we showcase art that is rarely seen in mainstream galleries. Art that reveals the myriad variations of the erotic, sparking conversations that lead to cultural and personal evolution.


